Mr. V Prakash Rao co-founder of Telangana RashtraSamithi and policy advisor to Chief Minister of Telangana gave a inspiring and informative speech on "WATER LITERACY". Espalier The Heritage School organized a kite making workshop inorder to bring out the creative and enthusiastic ideas that are embedded in the minds of the students. This fun-filled activity was conducted to encourage the students to work outdoors, to think creatively and to work together. It further taught the students how to plan with predicted outcomes as well as to develop skills and techniques to design and make something uplift against gravity. The ideology behind teaching the process is to make children understand the value of food that we eat and the effort that goes behind to grow these crops. They will be taken to next step of threshing the crop over the upcoming week

- Culinary Art Shankarpara, Karanji and Chakli making The festival of lights is around the corner and we all know how excited children get about the festival of Diwali. One of the reason for this excitement is of course the savoury sweets that they get to eat prepared lovingly by mothers and grandmothers. - Chess Club Every chess master was once a beginner To prove this statement Espalier The Heritage School hosted a Junior Chess Grandmaster & Chess Grandmaster Festival under the mentorship of coach VinayakWadile an International Chess Player to provide a platform for students to improve on logical thinking, analytical reasoning and problem solving. Students in the age group of 6 to 13 years participated in this mega event held on 21st January 2020 at the Innovation Hub in the school campus. It was heart-warming to see the 154 participants playing their moves like stalwarts with rapt concentration and collected demeanour. There were seven knock out rounds played using the latest FIDE rule in a time span of 15-15 mins. AnayTipre a student of Grade 2 bagged the Junior Chess Grandmaster Trophy &KabirPatil a student of Grade 4 carried home the Chess Grandmaster Trophy. All in all, it was a great experience as the students got a good opportunity to display their skills. It is rightly said that chess is a game wherein children learn to be responsible for their actions.
- Math Club The book of nature is written in the language of Mathematics"

 Galileo It's beautiful and its exciting and it's the only problem that we love to solve, That's right..Mathematics ! To encourage the children to pay more attention to this subject and leave it's fear behind the Heritage School organised Tables Champ for Grade 1 7. The preparation started a month

prior. Children were practicing tables , dodging tables , squares , square roots , cubes and cube roots daily in the school as well as in the bus with their Didis while they travelled, with great enthusiasm. The championship was conducted classwise. Children were asked random tables and then dodging. They were very well prepared and participated without any hesitation. Preparation prevents poor performance and this what only matters at the end. The first step towards eradicating the fear of mathematics is taken care of and now on theres no looking backwards.

- Music Club –Accolades for Heritage Students in their Maiden Musical Sojourn 100% results have been achieved by the students of Espalier-The Heritage School students at the Vocal Classical Music Exam conducted by GandharvaMahavidyalay, Mumbai which is the topmost authority in India for assessing students performance in Indian Classical music and dance. Vocal classical music ,Tabla and Kathak are a compulsory part of the performing arts curriculum at Heritage. All students from Grade 2 to 5 appeared for their PrarambhikPariksha in April 2019 while little vocalists from Grade 1 attempted SangeetParichay and all have passed with 80% of them scoring distinction ieVisheshPravinya They received expert training from the Music Maestro Dr. Ashish Ranade assisted by AparnaDidi and RasikKulkarniji. It is indeed a feather in the cap for the school.
- Science Club –Science Day was celebrated at Espalier- The Heritage School today. The Junior Scientists of Grade 1st to 7th participated with great enthusiasm and presented unique and innovative scientific ideas through various projects and models. More than 150 ideas were displayed. From simple to difficult.. From everyday science to latest technology From known to unknown... Science day taught students so many things... Also on the occasion of Leap year and Science day Espalier students got a LITTLE MORE...... To stimulate their science quest a Science park was inaugurated in the school. The inauguration was done by Leaper birthday girl Shaurya from Std II Innovators. It is a zone of scientific set up like Whispering discs, Echo tube and sympathetic tube. A memorable day in Espalier Heritage School... Having fun learning and exploring!!!!

- Literary Club –Marathi Bhasha Divas was celebrated in Espalier The Heritage School on 26th February, 2020 in honour of the Marathi language and in keeping with the birth anniversary of the late award winning poet V.V. Shirwadkar alias Kusumagraj. Marathi being the official language of the State of Maharashtra, the main focus of this celebration is to promote the Marathi culture among the Espalierites. The Chief Guest at our event was our very own Dada. The programme started with a Marathi prayer "Kharatohekchidhrama". The students narrated various categories of poem, proverbs, folk songs, manachesholk, stories and Dev Bajracha in Marathi. The icing on the cake was the skit on Natasamrat and dance by the teachers on the foot tapping Marathi song Paul padtepudhe.
- Peer Learning Session(Grade 3, 4 & 5) A peer learning session was conducted by Master Aarav MonaliPareshSoni from Grade 3 as a subject enrichment activity on the International Morse Code. Aarav who is an avid and voracious reader discussed about the origin of the Morse Code amongst his peers of Grade 3, 4 and 5 and went on to explain the entire International Morse Code for letters and numbers comprising of dits and dahs to his friends who listened very attentively to the explanation. A video on the usage of Morse Code by the military was also shown to the children The students then solved a skillsheet where they copied the Code and attempted to write their own name in the Espalier tradition with their mother's name in the middle alongside their father's name. They also attempted to write their parents cell phone number in Morse. This proved to be an interesting activity for the students which definitely increased their curiosity and alertness.
- The students of Grade 7 took a Social Initiative with Education on wheels The students of Grade 7 had their first social initiative experience with a project in collaboration with the NGO of Espalier i.e Education On Wheels, an initiative of Shri SachinUsha Vilas Joshi. They visited a slum area in Chincholi, Nashik. The NMC school of this area has children with poor

economic backgrounds , with parents working as workers and labourers. The Grade 7 students undertook a literacy campaign as their maiden activity with the children. The kids were first narrated a story tilted 'Wolf Wolf' along with finger puppets in Marathi , as an ice-breaker. The listeners aged 6 and 7 years responded well and were able to guess the moral of the story. They were then given an introduction to the English alphabet using flash cards. The children enjoyed repeating aloud A-Z along with names of related objects. The Heritage students also went around the NMC school , played with the little ones and returned after the activity realizing that they were indeed privileged to have all amenities, facilities and Education at home and school whilst there was a large community close to them which was deprived of basic facilities , health awareness and education. They could emphatise with those little children and promised to do more for them . They were guided and escorted by Sadhna Ma'am from the NGO.

- Creative Club -Siporex stone is a lightweight, precast building material that simultaneously provides structure, insulation, and fire and mould resistance. The school held an art activity for the children from Grade 1 - 7 of carving the Siporex brick. Abstract shapes and carvings were made by the children using various tools. The activity helps in developing sensory and motor skills and also requires a lot of discipline. The children had fun and some learning at the same time.
- Rakhi making activity-The bonding between a brother and sister is simply unique and is beyond description of words. The relationship between siblings is extraordinary and is given importance in every part of the world. However, when it comes to India, the relationship becomes all the more important as there is a festival called "RakshaBandhan" dedicated for the sibling love. Today the children brought the artist inside them to life by making beautiful Rakhis.They used paper ,thread and various decorative material to make rakhis.They used their own ideas to create beautiful rakhis. Rakhi in today's scenario though celebrated, as a sibling's festival, if

taken in true sense has a much broader perspective. The festival encompasses true sense of peace and brotherhood. The values propagated by the occasion if inculcated by all human beings can bring the muchneeded relief from the ongoing violence and mistrust.

• Shadu Mud Ganapati "Creativity is intelligence having fun." -- Albert Einstein The making of Ganpati Idol with Shadumatti at Espalier - The Heritage school began. The reason Shadu Clay is used because its a Natural clay. It is pollution free and helps to maintain the greenery environment. Shadu is a kind of a clay found in the river bank, mostly in the Konkan region of Maharashtra. The activity was taken classwise for all classes by Neha Didi and Mangesh Sir. Students were taught step by step process of making an idol. Children were deeply involved in making procedure of an idol and thoroughly enjoyed it too. The activity was taken too improve their hand motor skills and encourage them to be creative. The creative process allows a child to gain cognitive skills, scientific method, dexterity and exertion, problem solving and the ability to identify symbols, patterns and shapes. The most important aspect of creativity is the process of self-expression.

COMMUNITY WORK

The students meet together and execute various activities pertaining to their Clubs. We encourage our children to switch off all the appliances and the lights when not in use. We ensure taps are closed properly after use. And to make the students understand the concept of all four R's Reduce, Reuse ,Recycle and Refuse activities like Best out of waste , Swatchh Bharat etc. were performed in the school.
